RE: Aggregate Industries-WCR, Inc. Daniels Sand Pit No. 2 (M1973-007SG) Estimated Fountain Mutual Irrigation Canal Stabilization Construction Schedule

Dear Mr. Cazier,

The purpose of this letter is to present our proposed construction schedule for the stabilization of the Fountain Mutual Irrigation Canal (FMIC). The schedule, presented in Gantt Chart format attached, assumes that construction will begin in mid-December. This is a result of recent vandalization that has occurred to our main equipment (CAT D-8 Dozer) onsite planned for use in the construction. The vandalization was significant in that key components of the D-8 were removed completely. This requires ordering the parts directly from the manufacturer, and given that these parts are not considered normal wear and tear replacement parts, they have a long lead time for delivery. We have reached out to the manufacturer and have ordered the parts, with anticipated delivery around November 24th, 2020. Repairs will begin immediately upon receipt of the necessary parts.

As the schedule attached is only an estimate, we will notify the DRMS of any schedule changes as they become apparent, if necessary.

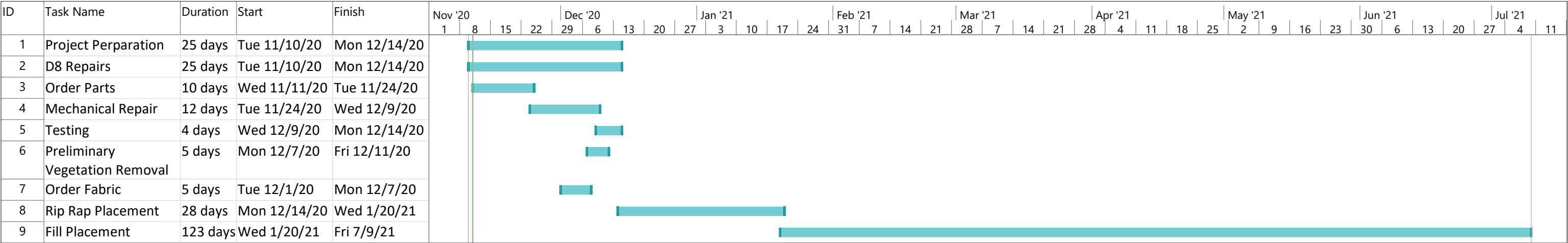
Additionally, the proposed schedule is weather and COVID-19 dependent. Negative developments in either of the categories could cause delays in the schedule, possibly significant delays.

We understand that the FMIC will be operating, beginning the week of November 16, 2020. While not anticipated at this time, leakage from the FMIC contributing to the groundwater conditions in the area (elevating) could impact construction timelines and/or methods.

We are committed to meeting our obligations for stabilizing the canal, and appreciate your consideration of Aggregate Industries proposed stabilization schedule.
