Mr. West:

Sunnyside Gold Corporation (SGC) submitted a Technical Revision in September 2020 for eight monitoring wells. During the 2020 field season at the Sunnyside Gold Mine it was determined that a ninth well should be drilled to further the investigation while weather permitted.

The well, MTMW-72 was drilled on the northern side of the Tailing Impoundment No. 4 to a depth of 171 feet and completed as a 2-inch monitoring well. MTMW-72 was constructed with PVC casing, steel surface riser and lockable cap.

This Sunnyside Gold update is to inform your office of all wells drilled and their locations during the 2020 Field Season related to Reclamation Permit No. M-1977-378.

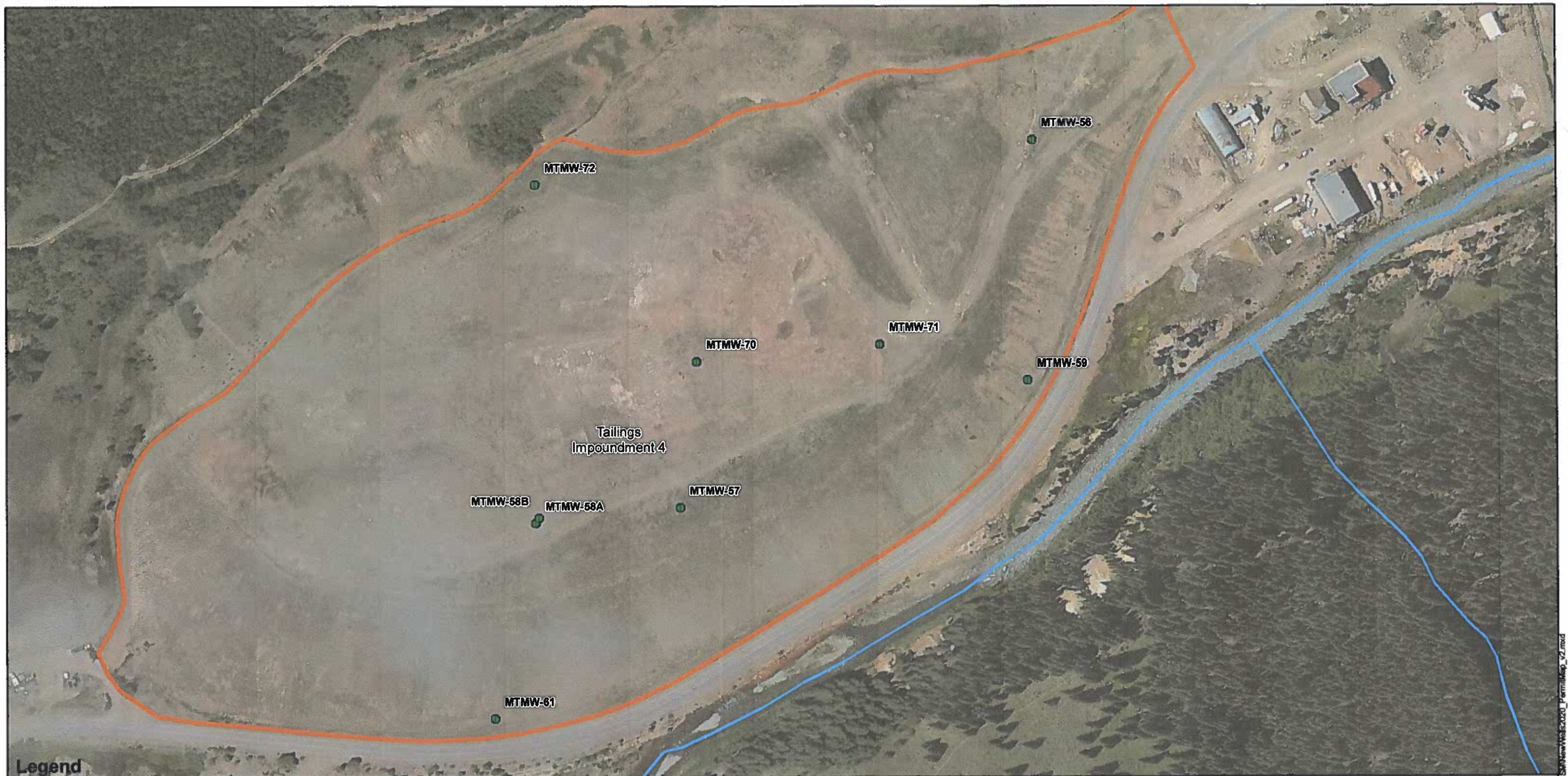
Well Locations
