RE: **Administrative Revision No. 2 (AD2), Withdrawal of affected land and liability increase associated with MR226.**

Minor Revision No. 226 (MR226) was approved in between the time when DRMS issued the proposed decision for Permit Revision No. 10 (PR10) and when the final decision was issued. Trapper Mining, Inc. (TMI), needed to conduct some topsoil stripping and the construction of a diversion channel prior to the onset of winter weather and therefore submitted MR226 for approval prior to issuance of PR10. The affected land and liability associated with the proposed activities under MR226 were covered under the PR10 submittal. Given that PR10 has been issued, the approval of MR226 is moot.

In order for the affected land associated with MR226 not to be double counted in the DRMS Permit System, and for TMI not be double bonded for this area, this Administrative Revision (AD2) was approved to reduce the affected land by 5.2 acres and to reduce the liability by \$20,251.26.
