OBSERVATIONS

This was a routine monitoring inspection conducted at The Broyles Pit by DRMS representative DJ Cunningham. A Michele Eichler was present during the inspection representing the Operator. This site is an active, 12.96 acre, 112c permit, where approximately 12 acres has been disturbed to date. The site was not active at the time of the inspection.

The site is divided into two sections, an eastern side and a western side. These two sections are connected by a haul road.

The site identification sign was posted at the mine entrance and the boundary was marked. A small stockpile of material was located on the western side of the permitted area. The eastern side has been graded at a 3H:1V slope The seeding has not yet taken hold and it is recommended that the Operator reseed the area.

No major issues were noted during the inspection.

The Division currently holds a financial warranty in the amount of \$12,023.00. Based upon observations made during this inspections, the Division finds this amount adequate to conduct reclamation.
