Scott is correct we have received the check and the receipt is laserfiche. Treasury is only open intermittently, so once it is deposited you will receive a formal response from the Division.

Rudy is correct. The maps included only showed the areas requesting to be released. They do not show the entire permit area, the revised/proposed permit boundary lines or any other changes that have occured to the site since the original submission more than 15 years ago. All maps need to comply with Rule 6.2.1(2), and more specifically revised mining and reclamation map requirements come from Rules 6.4.3 and 6.4.6.
