Mr. Mosch,

On December 4, 2020, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) received the Transfer of Mineral Permit and Succession of Operators Application for the Phoenix Mine, File No. M1982-075. The following items were determined to be incomplete with the application:

- 1. Performance Warranty: The notary stamp is illegible and the new Operator's name needs to be either written in or typed in rather than the former operator's name crossed out.
- 2. Financial Warranty: a new document under the new Operator's name is required for this transaction as well as an Affidavit of Authority. The Affidavit must be notarized; please see above note about previous notary stamps being illegible.

All completed permit documents are required to be submitted for consideration of the Request for Transfer of Mineral Permit and Succession of Operators Application. An incomplete application will be denied by the Division. Please provide the required documents to the Division by **February 9**, **2021** to complete the application.
