
The Teller County Planning Department has completed its review of the Newmont Mining Corporation's (CC&V) Technical Revision TR # 123 – VLF 2 Phase 2B, Part 1 Record of Construction – Construction Quality Assurance Report

1. Teller County understands that the Newmont Mining Corporation – CC&V is providing the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (DRMS) Technical Revision #123. This TR is a notice of the Record of Construction Quality Assurance Report for VLF 2 Phase 2B, Part 1. Teller County most recently reviewed the Quality Assurance Report for Parts 1 and 2 as part of TR# 117 and TR #118 and VLF 2 Phase 2A, Part 3 as part of TR #122.
2. The construction occurred between June 2019 and September 2019.
3. It is further understood that TR# 123 and the outlined Record of Construction report were authorized as a part of Amendment 10 to Permit No. M-1989-244. Additionally, the report includes both Quality Control and Construction Quality Assurance services for the construction which occurred between April 2019 through July 2019. There is no increase in the affected acreage of the Mined Land Reclamation Permit and any disturbance will be consistent with the previous level of disturbance. All activity will remain within the boundaries of the CCMOD. There is no material change in mining use and no additional impacts to Teller County services or infrastructure nor to adjacent or adjoining property owners. All of the standards outlined in Section 7 Mining Development Plan Standards are met and all of the current terms and conditions of the current MDP and all amendments will remain unchanged as a result of TR #123.

4. Teller County concurs with TR # 123 as written.
