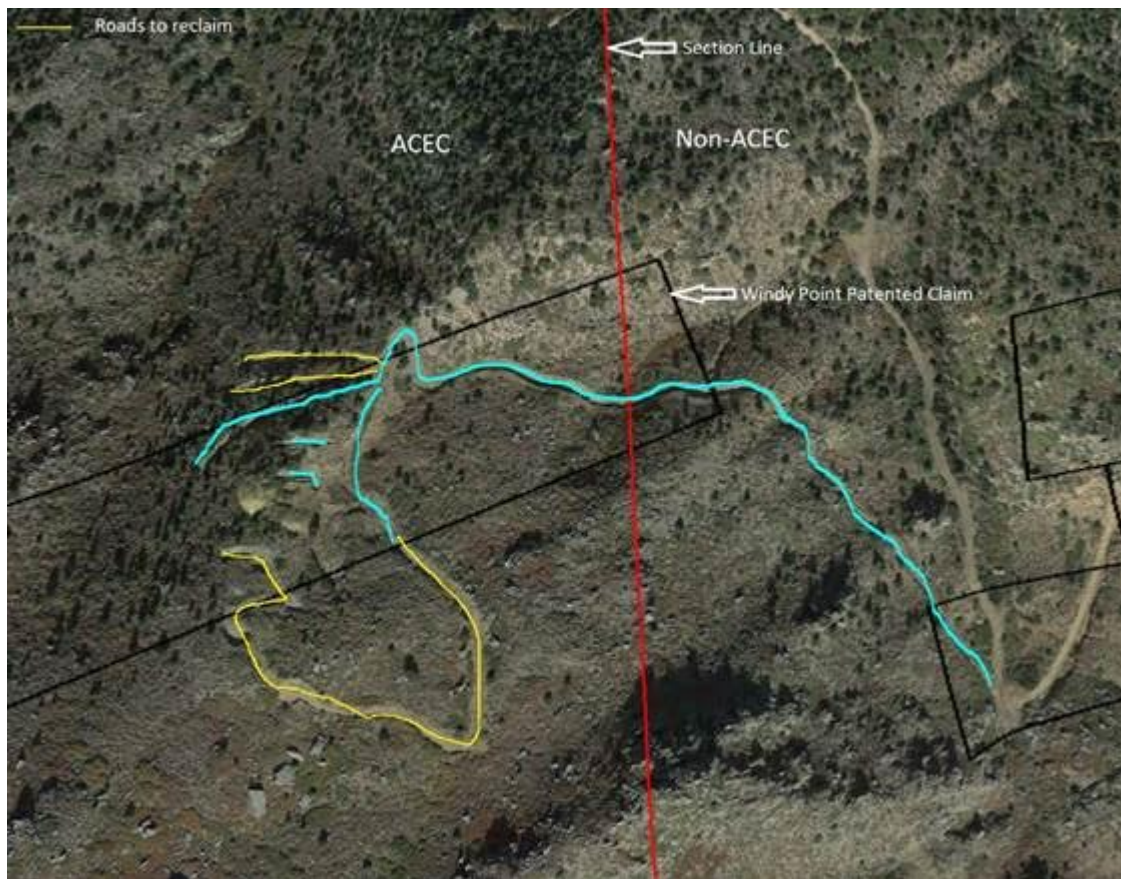
It all requires reclamation. The focus is the ACEC area as required by BLM in the March 2020 area.
