Dear Mr. Congdon,

On August 13, 2020, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) mailed a Reason to Believe (RTB) a violation exists regarding your 110c mining permit, permit no. M-1999-042, for failure to comply with the conditions of a permit, specifically failure to maintain legal right of entry and failure to maintain proper mine permitting with the United States Forest Service. This matter was scheduled for hearing before the Mined Land Reclamation Board (Board) on October 21-22. At the request of your attorney Mr. Richard Stephens, the hearing before the Board was continued to the January 20-21, 2020 hearing.

This notice is to inform you that given the specific continuance request made on January 11, 2021, this matter is being continued for a fourth time at your request. The Formal Public hearing is now scheduled before the Board to be held during the February 17-18, 2021 Board Meeting.
