Dear Mr. Cazier:

We received your correspondence dated December 10, 2020 on December 16, 2020 initiating consultation with our office in accordance with the Colorado State Register Act (Colorado Revised Statute (CRS) 24-80.1).

We understand that the timeline to receive comments and/or objections for the referenced application was fast-tracked to five working days after the application filing date, which was December 10, 2020. The referenced correspondence was not received by our office until December 16, 2020. We would like remind the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety that pursuant to (CRS 24-80.1) our office has thirty days upon receipt to respond.

A search of the Colorado Cultural Resource Inventory database indicates that four cultural resource inventories have been conducted in or near the proposed permit area, and no properties of historical significance have been recorded therein. Please keep in mind that our files contain incomplete information for this area, as most of Colorado has not yet been inventoried for cultural resources. As a result, there is the possibility that unidentified cultural resources exist within the proposed permit area. Should human remains be discovered during mining activities, the requirements under State law CRS 24-80 part 13 apply and must be followed.
