## **Waste Brick Import Fill Report**

**Quantity Imported:** 220 tons

**Timeframe hauled:** December 23-24, 2020

**Blending:** Blended with mine overburden and placed in 1' lifts and brick saw fines

**<u>Date backfilling completed:</u>** December 28, 2020.

The backfill work done in December 2020 allows the grog to be stockpiled in the pit instead of stockpiling on the clay stockpile pad area. This eliminates handling the brick one additional time. Then the brick is leveled in 1-foot lifts and another lift is added. The material coming from the brick plant contains saw mud from the cutting of brick into thin slabs. The saw mud fills the voids and aids in compaction. Further the loaded semitrucks are constantly driving over the backfill area aiding in compaction.
