On February 9, 2021, The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received your comment letter (and pictures) on behalf of Brian and Karen Nunnery of Lamar, CO. The comment was received within the public comment period which began on December 31, 2020 and will close on February 10, 2021.

Your comment letter has been forwarded to the operator of the West Farm Pit, Prowers Aggregate Operators, LLC. The letter was also sent to J&T Consulting, Inc. who is managing the Amendment 2 application process on behalf of the operator.

The Division requested to both Prowers Aggregate and J&T Consulting to reach out to you as well as provide the Division with a written response addressing the concerns outlined in your letter.
