A weed control plan is in place for the Jefferson County Pine Junction Pit. It consists of Spring and Fall property inspections to identify noxious weed species which may be present, followed by any necessary chemical applications. A Fall inspection showed mullein, kochia, knapweed, Canada thistle, scentless chamomile and myrtle spurge. Five acres of weeds were treated on 8/21/20 between 7:00 am and 3:00 pm using Hi-Dep and Ranger Pro.
