Re: Snowmass Mining Company Claims

Mr. Stephens:

I have recently learned that you have, on behalf of Mystic Eagle Quarry and Robert Congdon et al. (collectively, "Mystic Eagle"), represented in at least two different legal proceedings that Snowmass Mining Company's ("Snowmass") claims in the vicinity of the White Banks Mine in Pitkin County, Colorado have been forfeited. Although it is a matter of public record, you appear to be unaware that in September 2020, Snowmass located new mining claims at the same location as the former claims. The location of these new claims (CMC 294806-815) does not alter the finding of the Pitkin County District Court, upheld by the Colorado Court of Appeals, that Snowmass' previous claims were valid and senior to those of Mystic Eagle nor the finding that the ground upon which Mystic Eagle purported to locate its White Banks claims in August of 2005 was not open to location. I urge you to verify this new claim information and, once you have done so, I believe it is incumbent upon you to correct the statements you have made to the Colorado Department of Reclamation and Mine Safety, the United States District Court for the District of Colorado, and to any other tribunal or regulatory authority.
