- 1. Proof of publication of a public notice in Pikes Peak Courier, in Teller County and the State of Colorado, of the proposed mining operation is attached.
- 2. Proof that the public notice was provided to all owners of record of surface and mineral rights of the affected land and to the owners of record of all land surface within 200 feet of the boundary of the affected land is attached.
- 3. Snare Construction, Inc and Materials will adhere to all requests of the Colorado Division of Water Recourses
 - Snare Construction, Inc and Materials will adhere to the requirements under State law CRS 24-80 part 13 apply and must be followed as set forth by History Colorado.
- 4. There are two manmade structures withing 200 feet of proposed permit boundary, one is overhead utility line along a portion of northern permit boundary owned by IREA. Second there is a fence line located along a portion of the southern permit boundary owned by the Ernest Snare Living Trust.
- 5. An upper tributary of Grape Creek is located adjacent to the proposed northern permit boundary. This could receive drainage from the mine.
- 6. The proposed settlement ponds will be 50x50x6 with 3/1 slopes of all banks and capacity of proposed settlement pond will be 28,125 gallons. Depth of ground water is unknown, if ground water is encountered it will be backfilled to at least 2' above ground water level and pond size will be changed accordingly. We plan on the pond water leaching back into the ground and silt removal as needed. With no anticipated affect on Grape Creek.
- 7. A large portion of the site slopes to the north toward an upper tributary of Grape Creek. Storm water will be controlled along the northern permit boundary to protect offsite lands from sedimentation by using 1000 cubic yards of striped growth medium planned for reclamation to build a berm.
- Within Exhibit C, it was specified the depth of the deposit to be 95 feet and reclamation plan map identifies a 40-foot cut along the eastern boundary. We made a mistake it is not 95 feet it is in fact 40 feet.

 The woody vegetation which will be removed as part of the mining operation will be removed from the permit boundary and will be used for owners of Snare Construction, Inc and Materials personal heating use.
 All slopes within permit boundary during operation will always be 3/1.

12.1000 cubic yards of growth medium will be salvaged and stockpiled as the berm along the northern boundary above Grape Creek to protect off site lands from sedimentation. The berm will be seeded with Buffalo Brand Seed-mountain meadow mix to protect against wind and water erosion. The Eastern slope to be reclaimed will be a 3;1 slope and the 1000 cubic yards of growth medium will be spread onto the slope and seeded with Buffalo Brand Seed – mountain meadow mix at a rate of 30lbs per acre. (seed will be drilled into soil)

 - o 20% Winter Rye (Cereal Grain)
 - 20% Forage Perennial Ryegrass, VNS
 - o 20% Mountain Brome, Bromar
 - o 15% Timothy, Climax
 - o 14% Forage Kentucky Bluegrass, VNS
 - o 10% Orchardgrass, Potomac
 - o 1% Alsike Clover
