Dear Mr. Schnabel and Ms. Haley:

On February 22, 2021, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received the Application Form for Transfer of Mineral Permit and Succession of Operators from Continental Materials Corporation to the City of Colorado Springs for the Snyder Quarry, Permit M-1977-210. The following items are incomplete and need to be provided in order for the application to be processed:

- 1) The Application did not include demonstration of legal right of entry for the City of Colorado Springs.
- During the January 21, 2021 inspection, an overhead utility line was observed for which the owner was undetermined. If this powerline is not owned by the Successor, a structure damage compensation agreement is required.

Please return the required documentation to the Division before **March 25, 2021**. All completed permit documents are required to be submitted for consideration of your Request for Transfer of Mineral Permit and Succession of Operators Application. An incomplete application may be denied after **30** days from the submittal request, if requested documents or information are not received.
