## Re: Adequacy Review #2, Technical Revision TR-01 Mineral Mountain Project, Permit M-2014-045

Mr. Barker:

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) has reviewed your responses to the Division's November 13, 2020 Adequacy Review for Technical Revision TR-01 of the Mineral Mountain Project, Permit No. M-2014-045, and submits the following additional items. The decision date for TR-01 is March 16, 2021, therefore a response to the Division's Adequacy Review #2 should be submitted as soon as possible. Please respond to this follow-up adequacy item with a letter titled "Adequacy Review Response #2 TR-01; M-2014-045" summarizing the response to the numbered item below.

7. In response to Adequacy Item #1, the Operator states the drums of xanthate have already been relocated off-site and are being stored in a manner as recommended by the manufacturer. Please provide the manufacturer's recommendations for storage and describe how it is currently being stored.

This concludes the Division's Adequacy Review #2 of TR-01. Subsequent to receipt and review of the Operator's response to this item, the Division may identify additional items. As a reminder, please be advised TR-01 may be deemed inadequate, and the request may be denied on March 16, 2021, unless the above mentioned adequacy review item is addressed to the satisfaction of the Division.
