**Ames Construction Request for Mining Permit Decision Extension**

Dear Mr. Cazier,

We are currently still working on addressing inadequacies 3, 14, 15, and 18 from your Preliminary Adequacy Review letter, dated March 3, 2021.

Ames is currently at the below stages of completing the requested revisions:

- Inadequacy 3 – Ames has mailed the mining permit to their corporate office in Minnesota and is currently waiting for them to mail back the application including the corporate seal and corporate secretary signature.
- Inadequacies 14 & 15 – Ames has revised Exhibit E maps and has sent them off to Horrocks Engineers to get the new maps stamped by a Professional Engineer.
- Inadequacy 18 – Ames has reached out to all permanent man-made structure owners and Ames's attempt to reach said owners has been documented and sent. Currently, Ames is awaiting engineering assessments from Horrocks Engineers demonstrating that the structures shall not be damaged by the mining operation activities.

With these current outstanding items, we will not be able to revise and fix all inadequacies before Wednesday, March 10, 2021.

Ames is requesting to have your decision regarding the approval of the mining permit pushed back until Friday, March 19, 2021 to allow Ames adequate time to complete all inadequacies and satisfy all requests of the DRMS.
