CAUSE INFORMATION: A groundwater well was installed dowgradient from the passive water treatment system. They discovered that there was C30 and C10 hydrocarbons in this well that turned out to be on top of a historic machine shop that was used from about 1898 to 1960. Sneffels Creek runs next to the groundwater well, and has tested positive for small amounts of the hydrocarbons.
