## Re Toner Ranch Pit, File No. M-2021-011 Receipt of 110 Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Application Package

Dear Barton:

On March 9, 2021, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your 110 Construction Materials Reclamation Permit response to permit application incompleteness for the Toner Ranch Pit, File No. M-2021-011. A second review of the information received determined that the following additional information must be received before the Division can consider your application as being submitted and technical review can begin.

*Please submit separate Mining Plan Map and Reclamation Plan Map. Both maps submitted were on one* 8 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 11" paper. They need to be separated for filing purposes.

## Your application will not be considered submitted until all the information listed above is received and found sufficient to begin our review.

You have sixty (60) days from the above date to submit all necessary documents that the Office needs for an application to be considered filed. If, at the end of the sixty day period, the application has not been determined to be filed with the Office, the Office may deny the application and terminate the application file.

This letter shall not be construed to mean that there are no other technical deficiencies in your application. The Division will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submittal of all required items.
