ARC McClane Canyon, LLC, 2352 N 7th Street, Unit B, Grand Junction, CO, 81501, has filed with the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety a complete application for the renewal of a valid existing permit to conduct mining in Colorado for its McClane Canyon Mine, Mining and Reclamation Permit No. C-1980-004.

The McClane Canyon Mine is located approximately 19 miles north of Loma, CO along State Highway 139. East Salt Creek is immediately west of the permit boundary. The permit area is encompassed within the following lands:
