We will be accessing our claim by pick-up truck via Boreas Pass Road when open, dropping down to Selkirk Campground Forest Road 406. Our claim is located just past the campground on the west side of the road. Corners of claim will be clearly marked with 5 ft PVC (capped-non-perforated) white post. We would like to run our 2" Keene backpack dredge in 2 small areas approx. 12x12 (144 sq.) to 200 square feet towards the back edge. Claim and work area are marked on the map provided. All disturbances will be filled back in with rocks and/or any soils removed. We would like to start running around the 15th of June thru November 2021 approx. maybe 3 times a month. We do not plan to build any type of trails that would disturb the area.


