Re: Miller Midwest, File No. P-2021-004, Filing Deficiencies

Dear Mr. Miller:

On March 22, 2021 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your Notice of Intent to Conduct Prospecting application for the Miller Midwest site. Our initial review indicates that your application is incomplete for the purposes of filing. The following filing deficiencies need to be addressed before the application can be considered complete and filed:

1. **Documentation of Legal Right to Enter:** Pursuant to Rule 5.1.2(d)(vi) the applicant must provide documentation of the legal right to enter to conduct prospecting and reclamation. This may include a copy of a lease, deed, abstract of title, a current tax receipt, or a signed statement by the Landowner (s) and acknowledged by a Notary Public stating that the Prospector has legal right to enter to conduct prospecting and reclamation. Since this site is on a claim administered by the US Forest Service, please submit proof that the claim has been filed and accepted.

Please also note, the USFS may also require permitting documentation of an approved permit or letter stating that no permit is required will be required before your NOI application can be accepted.

2. **Financial Warranty:** Pursuant to Rule 5.3.3 the minimum required financial warranty of \$2,000.00 must be submitted for the application to be considered complete and filed. Please submit the required financial warranty. As part of the Technical Review Period a reclamation cost estimate will be performed, any additional financial warranty required will be addressed under a separate cover and prior to your NOI Application being accepted.

Per Rule 5.3.1(b) the applicant shall address all identified deficiencies within 60 days of the date of this notice. Please submit your responses to the above listed items no later than Friday May 28, 2021. If your response nor a written request for an extension is not received by May 28, 2021 your application may be denied.
