On February 10, 2021 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your comment regarding the Toner Ranch Pit, File No. M-2021-011. Your comment has been received however was submitted outside of the applicable public comment period therefore, your comment has been deemed untimely and you are not qualified for party status at this time.

At this time the application is not considered complete for the purposes of fling. Once the application is considered complete for the purposes of filing, the applicant must publish public notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the locality of the proposed mining operations pursuant to Construction Materials Rule 1.6.2(1)(d). Written comments, protests or petitions for a hearing must be received by the office not more than ten (10) days after the last date of publication.
