Dear Mr. Bear:

On April 1, 2021, the Division received BRL's application for Bond Release Number 7 (SL-07). The following issues regarding the SL-07 submittal must be addressed before the Division can call the application complete:

1. Regarding Item #3 on the first page of the submittal, the current permit was issued in 2018, not 2013.
2. Regarding Item #6 on the first page of the submittal, if the reclaimed pond at the ROM area is going to be included in this application, there should be two phases listed: Phase II and Phase III.
3. Rule 3.03.2(1)(e) requires a notarized statement certifying that all reclamation activities have been accomplished in accordance with the Act, Rules, and reclamation plan in the PAP. Please point to this in the SL-07 submittal, or provide this statement in your response to this review. (Note that a notarized statement was included in the SL-06 application for this mine.)
