Mr. Scott,

On behalf of Stan Opperman. Hope your new year is going well. I wanted to report to you that we discovered a small area of settlement on the west slope in the quarry. Ground Engineering was doing a site inspection for us and found the area. It was approximately 20' x 20' and had settled about one foot in the center. The location of the disturbance is all the way to the north in the lower third of the slope.

Ground Engineering did not note any water issues or other movement except this one area. Their recommendation was to track the area in, in order to consolidate the material in this area.

We took an excavator back in that area today, leveled the area and tracked it in. Our foreman said it appeared to be settlement of loose soil over some rock in that area. The march snow fall may have had some effect on this.

We continue to do a weekly inspection including pictures and this is the first depression that has been noted. We have also had the area surveyed twice since completion and our benchmarks show no movement horizontally or vertically. We will monitor the area and let you know if anything changes.

All the weekly reports, survey information, Ground Engineering reports will be submitted with the Annual Report in July 2021. If you have any questions, feel free to call.
