Dear Roberts:

On April 5, 2021, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your 112c Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Application package for the Rifle Pit #1, File No. M-2021-021. Preliminary review of the information received determined that the following additional information must be received before the Division can consider your application as being submitted and technical review can begin.

- Rule 1.6.2- No signed affidavit was included with the application.
- Permit Acreages throughout the application are inconsistent. Any impacts to the land associated with mining needs to be within the permit boundary. Specifically the dewatering pipeline that runs from the pit to the Colorado River is an improvement in support of mining and needs to be permitted. Lack of including this pipeline within the permit boundary was one of the reasons why File No. M-2020-008 was denied.
- Application form #6 and 7, Change to 'Scotts Contracting, Inc.'
- Application form #9, Provide the Quarter Section
- Do not start newspaper publication until the application is filed and called complete. Include the future mining use. End of comment period is dependent on date of publication.

**Your application will not be considered submitted until all the information listed above is received and found sufficient to begin our review.**

You have sixty (60) days from the above date to submit all necessary documents that the Office needs for an application to be considered filed. If, at the end of the sixty day period, the application has not been determined to be filed with the Office, the Office may deny the application and terminate the application file.

This letter shall not be construed to mean that there are no other technical deficiencies in your application. The Division will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submittal of all required items.
