Dear Mr. Bear:

The Division received the MR-204 submittal from Tamme Bishop (Stover & Associates) on April 15, 2021. Rather than change Stipulation 35, the Division has decided that we shall terminate that stipulation. In its place, we will add a Monitoring Report requirement to our Permit System to track your submittal and our review of the annual reports for the coverfill surveys.

Regarding the proposed PAP text in the MR-204 submittal, we ask that you revise the text to be more specific. You should state something similar to one of the following:

- The stand-alone report shall be submitted annually by December 31st.
- The report shall be submitted annually and included in the Waste Bank Inspection Report for the Fourth Quarter, which is due by February 1st of each year.
