Exhibit S – Permanent Man-made Structures

There are several structures on the private portion of the Parkdale Quarry which are owned by Martin Marietta and which may remain after the site is reclaimed, including the original Harvey Ranch residence and associated outbuildings, an historic stone corral structure on the north side of Tallahassee Creek, and a metal shop building. The office, scale, and scale house structures will be removed prior to or during final site reclamation. Black Hills Energy has a powerline and Royal Gorge Express Railroad has rail tracks along the southern permit boundary, but more than 200 feet from the mine excavation. County Road 157 dead ends at the permit boundary, more than 200 feet from the mine excavation. There are no other structures within 200 feet of the permit boundary.
