OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. A representative for the operator was not present. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The Pribble Pit is located approximately 2.5 miles east of Dove Creek and accessed from H Road. The site is a 110c operation that includes a total of 7.0 permitted acres. Because the site is operated by a county the Division does not hold a financial warranty for this site.

Adequate mine identification signage was noted at the entrance to the site.

The affected area was marked by berms clearly visible and adequate to delineate the affected area boundary.

No equipment was noted on site. Several materials stockpiles are located in the pit area. Topsoil is stockpiled along the east permit boundary.

The site is well-kempt. No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
