The Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety (Division) has reviewed the responses for the first adequacy letter sent 4/16/21 for the above referenced revision. Please find below the remaining adequacy review items that will need to be addressed prior to the Division's approval of the revision. The numbering has been maintained from the first adequacy letter and referenced if the item has been resolved.

- 1. Please provide the Division with a proof of publication. *Provided with response letter dated 4/27/21*
- 2. With regard to Facilities PMT Map 31a Backfill & Regrade Boundaries:
  - **a.** Please label map contours so that the Division is able to verify the proposed changes to backfill volumes. *Provided with response letter* 4/27/21.
  - **b.** Please specify what is intended by "Design Contours". It is unclear if these contours are intended as post mining topography or some other elevation. *Provided with response letter* 4/27/21.
  - c. Please provide greater detail on the map, specifically in the Pit Lake and portal area as the Division is not able to verify the proposed volumes with the map provided. <u>Unresolved</u> please see Item 3.
  - d. Please modify the colors of the contours so that "Existing Contours" and "Design Contours" can be distinguished from each other. *Provided with response letter* 4/27/21.
- 3. Please provide the Division with dimensions or cross sections for the Pit Lake and portal areas. This Division is not able to verify the amount of fill that will be needed to backfill these areas with the map provided.
