#### **OBSERVATIONS**

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. A representative for the operator was not present. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The H & H Quarry #2 is located approximately four miles west of Cahone and accessed from CR 8.5. The site is a 110c operation that includes a total of 9.9 permitted acres. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$6,347.00 for this site. The Division has reviewed the reclamation costs, in order to ensure the financial warranty reflects the actual current cost of fulfilling the requirements of the Reclamation Plan, and determined that the current financial warranty amount is sufficient.

Adequate mine identification signage was noted at the entrance to the site.

The affected area consists of two pit areas, one active, and an historic pit that has undergone reclamation. In the active pit there is a vertical sandstone highwall approximately 10-15 feet in height and approximately 300 feet in length. Overburden is stockpiled on the west side of the pit floor. The active pit area is orderly and well-kempt. No trash or debris were noted. Noxious weed infestations were not observed. Reclamation of the historic pit area looks good. Grading blends well with the surrounding topography and vegetation is becoming well established.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
