- 2. **Exhibit R Proof of Filing with County Clerk and Recorder:** Please submit an affidavit or receipt indicating the date on which the application was placed with the local County Clerk and Recorder for public review, pursuant to Rule 1.6.2(1)(c).

The application cannot be filed until all the items/information listed above is received and found sufficient to begin our review. Please submit all necessary documents in order to address the above listed deficiencies within sixty days. If, after sixty days, the application is still incomplete, the Division may deny the application and terminate the application file.

This letter shall not be construed to mean that there are no other technical deficiencies in your application. Once the application is filed, the Division will review the application in order to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the *Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Act* (Act) and the associated *Mineral Rules and Regulations of the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board for Hard Rock, Metal, and Designated Mining Operations* (Rules).
