**RE: Aggregate Industries-WCR, Inc. Daniels Sand Pit No. 2 (M1973-007SG) Slope Stabilization Construction Update (April 17 through May 13, 2021)**

Dear Mr. Cazier,

The purpose of this letter is to present a construction update to Aggregate Industries-WCR, Inc. Daniels Sand Pit No. 2 (M-1093-007SG) (Daniels) slope stabilization project. This update covers construction activities that occurred through May 13, 2021.

As discussed in the proposed schedule memorandum dated November 11, 2020, we began in Mid-December 2020, with initial tasks which includes developing all protections, placing the appropriate safety signage, and specific training to personnel who will be assigned to the project. Site preparation also occurred in December, 2020.

At our direction, placing of any material into the water cannot occur with an ice thickness greater than 2 inches in thickness. This is to limit settling of the material upon ice melt, which could cause slope instabilities to develop from shifting material. As of May 13, 2021, site personnel have an additional 35,000 tons of concrete riprap into the water (approximately halfway across). The volume of material placed has significantly increased recently due to warmer weather. We anticipate this reclamation pace to continue through project completion.

At this time, we still anticipate completion to align with the proposed construction schedule submitted to the DRMS on November 12, 2020, with construction completion in early July, 2021.

We are committed to meeting our obligations for stabilizing the canal, and will present the next construction progress update on June 15, 2021.
