RE: Schwartzwalder Mine, Permit No. M-1977-300, Approval of Alternate Reporting Schedule for Required Water Monitoring

Mr. Harrington:

On May 5, 2021, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received your request for an alternate reporting schedule for the required quarterly water monitoring at the Schwartzwalder Mine. The Division has recently begun requiring operators to submit any required quarterly water monitoring data within 30 days of the last day of that quarter. However, according to your request, additional time is needed for this site due to various factors, including the analytical turnaround time required for radiological analytes.

After considering your request, the Division has approved the following alternate reporting schedule for this site:

- 1<sup>st</sup> quarter data due by June 1
- 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter data due by September 1
- 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter data due by December 1
- 4<sup>th</sup> quarter data due by March 1 (of the following year)

Please be advised, a failure to submit the required monitoring data by the deadline above may result in enforcement actions (unless a case-specific extension has been approved by the Division prior to the applicable deadline).
