Mr. Craig:

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) is in the process of reviewing the above referenced application in order to ensure that it adequately satisfies the requirements of the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Act (Act) and the associated Mineral Rules and Regulations of the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board for Hard Rock, Metal, and Designated Mining Operations (Rules). During review of the material submitted, the Division determined that the following issue(s) of concern shall be adequately addressed before the application can be considered for approval.

1. Exhibit E Mining Plan Map: Pursuant to Rule 6.3.5 (2) (a) please outline and label the permit boundaries, described in Exhibit A - Legal Description; for all 110 Limited Impact Operations, the Division considers the area bounded by the permit boundary to be analogous to the affected area.

It is unclear on the Mining Plan Map what area makes up the proposed 9.6 acre permit area. Please label the permit boundary on the Mining Plan Map.

2. Exhibit G - Source of Legal Right to Enter: Pursuant to Rule 6.3.7 please provide documentation of the legal right to enter to conduct mining and reclamation for Owners of Record described in Rule 1.6.2(1)(e)(i). This may include a copy of a lease, deed, abstract of title, a current tax receipt, or a signed statement by the Landowner(s) and acknowledged by a Notary Public stating that the Operator/Applicant has legal right to enter to conduct mining and reclamation.

The application includes an agreement wherein CJK Milling Company, LLC grants Union Milling Contractors, LLC right to enter. Please provide documentation showing CJK Milling Company, LLC as owner of the affected area.

Please submit your response(s) to the above listed issue(s) by Friday, June 18, 2021 in order to allow the Division sufficient time for review.
