OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. The permit was transferred to SSG Holdings, LLC in June 2019. A representative for the operator was not present. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The Rock Gulch Pit is located approximately .5 miles south of Salida and accessed from CR107. The site is a 112c operation that includes a total of 26.1 permitted acres. Approximately 13 acres are currently disturbed by the operation. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$31,000.00 for this site. The Division has reviewed the reclamation costs, in order to ensure the financial warranty reflects the actual current cost of fulfilling the requirements of the Reclamation Plan, and determined that the current financial warranty amount is sufficient.

Adequate mine identification signage was noted at the entrance to the site.

The affected area was marked by fencing and posts that were clearly visible and adequate to delineate the affected area boundary.

The power pole that was located within the pit has been re-located outside the pit area.

Mining is progressing toward the south. The operator has committed to maintaining 3H:1V slopes at this site. Steep slopes were not observed during this inspection. Crushing and processing equipment, topsoil and materials stockpiles are located in the pit area.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
