New Remarks

On June 2, 2021, I inspected the Rifle Quarry with DRMS Environmental Protection Specialist, Amy Yeldell, to check on the progress of final reclamation within the remaining 1.65 permitted acres and ensure compliance with the Final Reclamation Plan (which was authorized July 1, 2016). Signage was present at the southeast corner of the main quarry area. The weather was sunny with temperatures in the 60's.

The access road is blocked with boulders per the Final Reclamation Plan. There was evidence of approved alternative growth media and mulching material (a combination of fish emulsion solids, spent grain solids, spent potato mash solids, mulch, and topsoil) on the surface of the road. Within the quarry floor, Pete Lien & Sons, Inc. previously performed weed eradication, site stabilization, and erosion control. Per the Final Reclamation Plan, there were five 24" tall sediment control windrows running perpendicular to the west-to-east gradient on the quarry floor. In addition, a trench lined with rip-rap, was constructed on the western side of the quarry floor.

The eastern slope, the quarry floor, the northern upper access bench, as well as most of the remaining quarry area contained signs of adequate revegetation with new spring regrowth of grasses and sage present. There was no evidence of gullying or erosion, the elongated windrows and trench effective at trapping any eroded sediment. The vegetation on the quarry floor also appeared to prevent any additional erosion.
