OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. Eli Perez, representing the Operator, was present during this inspection. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The Avery Construction Pit is located approximately one mile south of Buena Vista and accessed from Gregg Drive. The site is a 112c operation that includes a total of 131.36 permitted acres. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$291,550.00 for this site. The Division has reviewed the reclamation costs, in order to ensure the financial warranty reflects the actual current cost of fulfilling the requirements of the Reclamation Plan, and determined that the current financial warranty amount is sufficient.

Adequate mine identification signage was noted at the entrance to the site.

The affected area was marked by fencing that was clearly visible and adequate to delineate the affected area boundary.

This is an active mine which serves as ACA's center of operations for the area. Nearly all of the permit area has been disturbed. Mining is nearing completion in the west end of the permit area. Conveyors are set up to transport material from mining areas to the processing area located in the central part of the permit area. Slope reduction has commenced around areas that are mined out. Mining and crushing are active in the AM-2 area.


Product stockpiles are located throughout the pit. Wash ponds, batch plants and equipment are located on the east end of the permit area. Fuels stored on site are in appropriate containment structures.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
