OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. Eli Perez, representing the Operator, was present during this inspection. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The River Park Recreation Access site is located approximately 2.5 miles southeast of Buena Vista and accessed from CR 301. The site is a 110c operation that includes a total of 9.9 permitted acres. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$32,550.00 for this site. The Division has reviewed the reclamation costs, in order to ensure the financial warranty reflects the actual current cost of fulfilling the requirements of the Reclamation Plan, and determined that the current financial warranty amount is sufficient.

Adequate mine identification signage was noted at the entrance to the site.

The affected area was marked by posts that were clearly visible and adequate to delineate the affected area boundary.

Mining is complete at the site and final reclamation has commenced. All equipment has been removed from the site. Backfilling of slopes is underway. Topsoil is staged in berms around the crest of the pit. The pit floor is graded flat and free of equipment or refuse. A gravel stockpile remains in the north end of the pit.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
