CONDITIONS FOR APPROVAL

The proposed operation does not anticipate exposing groundwater. Therefore, exposure of ground water must not occur during or after mining operations.

The applicant has indicated plans to use water for dust control. The source of water for this use has not been identified, however the applicant indicated that water will be provided by water truck and off-site water supply. The Applicant will need to document that the water proposed to be used at the site was obtained from a legal source that allows such industrial use.

COMMENTS: If stormwater runoff is intercepted by this operation and is not diverted or captured in priority, it must be released to the stream system within 72 hours. This may require a discharge permit from CDPHE-WQCD. Otherwise, the operator will need to make replacements for evaporation.
