Dear Mr. West:

In 2019, Idarado Mining Company (IMC) updated the Reclamation Plan in Technical Revision (TR) 2. As part of the Reclamation Plan update, the existing maintenance shop was proposed to be demolished in accordance with applicable laws and regulations. In addition, the foundation for the existing maintenance shop was to be broken up and capped with soil and seeded.

IMC would like to request a modification to the Reclamation Plan for the existing maintenance shop. We want to keep the existing air handling equipment, currently located within the existing maintenance shop, intact as a visual historic artifact. A photo of the air handling equipment is attached to this report. Only the main air handling equipment will remain. Any connective piping or insulation will be removed. The rest of the existing maintenance shop will be demolished and reclaimed as identified in TR-2.

This modification to the Reclamation Plan will remain consistent with the general site post reclamation intent. The existing Reclamation Plan already allows the mill foundation and three structures to stay onsite to provide a visual historical artifact for sightseers driving along Highway 550 or stopping at the CDOT owned historical overlook located adjacent to the Site.

The rest of the Reclamation Plan will remain the same.
