RE: Reduction of Groundwater Level Monitoring Frequency from Monthly to Quarterly; Pueblo East Pit, Permit No. M-2000-041

Dear Ms. Schreiber,

On July 5, 2021, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received a request to reduce the frequency of groundwater level monitoring from monthly to quarterly at the Pueblo East Pit, Permit No. M-2000-041. As you indicated in Appendix H of the approved Amendment 1 (AM-1) frequency of monitoring is to be reduced from monthly to quarterly upon completion of the slurry wall. The SEO approved the slurry wall leak test on July 10, 2019. The Division agrees the frequency of monitoring can be reduced to quarterly.
