Hello Matthew,

I understand you have been working with DJ Cunningham with DRMS on this project and that DJ provided you with some additional information and maps. DJ has resigned his position with DRMS and I will be processing the New Elk Mine permit revision application moving forward. I wanted to get some clarification. New Elk Coal Company's proposal does not include a plan for additional surface disturbance and they are not anticipating subsidence to occur given their method of mining. Based on their proposal, there should not be any surface impact. We are reviewing their plan to confirm that subsidence should not occur and at this point this will likely be the case. Since no additional surface disturbance is proposed or likely to result from subsidence, will a cultural resource survey be necessary as indicated in your comment letter?
