RE: M1990-057 | Tailings Dam Lining Schedule

Dear Dustin,

Per our current M1990-057(110d) permit, UMC are sending this letter to inform you of the schedule to install the lining system for the tailings dam. The schedule, subject to weather and contractor productivity, is as follows:

- Aug 16-27: Earthworks. Hollingsworth Construction will dress previously constructed pit slopes to smooth-out weathering of the slopes that occurred since original construction
- Aug 30 Sep 5: Earthworks. Hollingsworth will start digging anchor trench on top of the embankment.
- Sep 6-10: Liner Installation. Simbeck will install the liner. They will install the GCL, drain mat, and liner on one section each day. For example, on the South slope, they will do all 3 layers in one day, and the next day they will do another section. The expected duration of the liner system installation will therefore be 5 days.
- Sep 7-16: Earthworks. Hollingsworth will backfill anchor trench as sections become available. Rip Rap will be laid on spillway after Simbeck has completed the liner installation. Finally, concrete barriers will be placed along the North edge of the tailings facility to prevent vehicles from driving into the dam.

Please let us know when the Division wishes to make its inspections, and Steve Craig, our on-site Construction Manager will coordinate your schedule with the installation and earthworks contractors.
