RE: Adequacy Review No. 2; Technical Revision (TR-2); Sheep Mountain Ranch, Permit No. M-2017-022

Dear Ms. Brady,

On August 27, 2021, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received a request for Technical Revision (TR-2) to update the reclamation plan map to reflect the current conditions at the Sheep Mountain Ranch site, Permit No. M-2017-022. Please be advised that on September 29, 2021, the application for TR-2 may be deemed inadequate and denied unless the following adequacy items are addressed to the Division's satisfaction. On August 31, 2021 the operator's representative responded to the Division's Preliminary Adequacy Review dated August 31, 2021. After review of the responses the Division has an additional item that need to be addressed or clarified. Please respond to the adequacy items with a letter summarizing each response, to the numbered items below, in a cover letter titled "Adequacy Review No. 2 Response TR-2, M-2017-022".

- 1. The operator's representative made clear part of TR-2 was to seek release of the entire permit area. Please note that the Division cannot release a permitted site from reclamation liability through a technical revision. An operator may seek release following Rule 4.17. A permit release request form has been attached for your convenience. Please note the release request must be submitted separate from any other communication and not part of any other permitting action. Additionally, the Division will not consider a release request until TR-2 has been approved.
- 2. Additional clarification is needed, there is an annotation on the map stating "Possible Irrigation Pipe Currently unused", was a pipe installed?
- 3. The structure in the southeast corner of the permit boundary is located outside the permit boundary on the map, please show the correct location of this structure. Does the structure serve as an outfall for the pipeline or another purpose?
- 4. Pursuant to Rule 6.2.1(2), the map must be signed by a qualified person.



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This concludes the Division's adequacy review no. 2 of your technical revision. The Division reserves the right to further supplement this document with additional adequacy items and/or details as necessary.

The decision date for your application is set for September 29, 2021. However, please allow the Division sufficient time to complete its review by submitting your response no later than five (5) working days prior to the decision date. If additional time is needed to respond, an extension request must be received by our Office by the decision date. If on the decision date, outstanding adequacy items remain, and no extension request has been received, your revision may be denied.
