OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. A representative for the operator was not present. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The Skoglund Pit is located approximately 9.3 miles east of Moffat and accessed from CR 66T. The site is a 112c operation that includes a total of 30 permitted acres. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$20,000 for this site. The Division has reviewed the reclamation costs, in order to ensure the financial warranty reflects the actual current cost of fulfilling the requirements of the Reclamation Plan, and determined that the current financial warranty amount is sufficient.

Adequate mine identification signage was noted at the entrance to the site.

The affected area was marked by posts and fencing that were clearly visible and adequate to delineate the affected area boundary.

Approximately 19 acres are currently disturbed by the operation. Mining is progressing to the south and east. Pit highwalls have been regraded to approximately 3H:1V. Vegetation is becoming well established in the reclaimed areas. Several materials stockpiles are located on the pit floor. Fuel observed on site was in adequate containment.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
