OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. A representative for the operator was not present. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The Mystic Soil site is located approximately 1.5 miles north of Hooper and accessed from CR B. The 112c application was approved by the Division on March 31, 2021. The required financial warranty, in the amount of \$173,806, has not yet been posted by the operator. So therefore, the permit has not yet been issued. The operator has until March 31, 2022 to post the financial warranty. Once issued, the permit will include an affected area of 319.8 acres, of which 115.9 acres are expected to be mined. The required financial warranty is based on a maximum disturbance area at any given time of 35 acres.

This inspection confirmed that mining has not commenced at the site.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
