### **COMMENTS**

This was a complete inspection of the Foidel Creek Mine; DRMS Permit No. C-1982-056, operated by Twentymile Coal, LLC. (TC). This inspection was conducted by Tabetha Lynch with the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety (Division). Kevin Copeland of TC accompanied the inspection. Overall the weather was smokey and hot during the inspection. The mine was dry during the inspection.

Site was very dry during inspection, ponds at facilities area have been cleaned since last ground inspection at the end of July. Pond B access road berms have been reestablished (photo below)



Pond B shown below has been recently cleaned, and is not discharging.



Pond D was discharging and recently cleaned shown below.



Ponds F and G were holding a small amount of water but not discharging. Pond T and C were dry.

A piece of belt was in drainage ditch behind a shop between Ponds F and G shown below, will need to be removed.



Scrap metal items marked with a red X will be removed from the site in the near future.

Waste pile appeared to be on the  $4^{th}$  lift and stable and dry. Haul trucks were not running to the waste pile at the time of inspection. Shown below.



No cattle were observed on the site.

Topsoil piles appeared stable.

Weeds were noted in the area of Pond T.

Drilling and pipe burial were occurring at the 15L pad shown below.





The 16L dewatering borehole is currently functioning and construction has not yet started on the replacement dewatering borehole.

Tipple phase I released area appears stable, shown below



Wetlands passive treatment ponds off the 6MN road were holding water and wetland vegetation appears to be doing very well. Shown below.
