L.G. Everist, Inc. respectfully submits this cover letter and map to accompany the online submittal of the DRMS Annual Report for Carr Gravel Resource, DRMS Permit # M-1988-048. The annual fee has been paid online with a credit card.

L.G. Everist's Carr Gravel Resource permit area is 521 acres. The attached **Exhibit C1 - Mining Plan Map** shows the current permit boundary. The mine site permit area is south-east of the Town of Carr, located in parts of Section 1, Township 10 North, Range 67 West, 6th P.M., Weld County. The current mining area, plant site area, and bone yard (equipment storage) area are shown on the attached Mining Plan Map.

In areas where mining is complete, reclamation is on-going - the areas have been topsoiled and seeded, and the grass is slowly growing. Weeds are controlled as needed throughout the year with spraying and mowing. In the past year, mining-related activity occurred within the same previously disturbed mining area, and some finished products were used from stockpiles. Market demand is slow right now, with decreased oil and gas activity (our biggest customers). The permit area is inspected regularly as required for compliance with safety regulations and permit compliance.
